

How to set up Zoom to send multiple streams to Panopto

1. Go to your Zoom account at <https://upenn.zoom.us>
2. Click on SETTINGS
3. Click on RECORDING
4. Click the box for “Record active speaker, gallery view and shared screen separately”
5. Click on all of the three options that appear
6. Then click the Save button to complete the process.
